Age category

- *Grade R* is age four turning five by 30 June in the year of admission;
- *Grade 1* is age five turning six by 30 June in the year of admission.

Application process

- Application forms are obtainable from the school. Parents are required to complete these forms and return them to the Administrator of the school.

- The Administrator deals with all applications.
- The procedure is open and fair.

Documents required

- Copy of Birth certificate of the child.
- Copy of immunization certificate of the child.
- ID Copy of Parent.
- Proof of residence.
- Referral letter of attendance, if learner is from another school.

Additional documents required if the child is not a South African citizen:

- Study Permit.
- Temporary or permanent residence permit from the Department of Home Affairs; or
- Evidence that parents have applied for permission to stay in South Africa.
